- 2. Please present the Confidential Reference form to the pupil's current school Secretary. This form must be completed and returned by the current school to Hermitage House via e-mail to info@hermitagehouse.co.za
- 3. The Application can only proceed to the interview stage once all of the above have been received. Receipt of the above does not guarantee the granting of an interview.
- 4. Admission to the school is subject to available space, curriculum compatibility and the ability of Hermitage House to serve your family's needs in terms of our mission statement. Should we be unable to assist you, we will notify you in writing. Alternatively, we will contact you to arrange an interview.
- 6. The pupil will be required to complete an entrance evaluation or school readiness evaluation as part of the interview process.
- 7. The school will notify you of the outcome of your evaluation. Should your application be successful, an information pack including details of uniform, textbook and stationery requirements will be issued to you, as well as admission documents.
